IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Employment of Minors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

26 MRSA § 773, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 238, § 2, is amended to read:

The provisions of this section pertaining to hotels shall not apply to minors under 16 years of age who are employed in outdoor occupations on the grounds of a hotel; **nor shall it apply to minors under 16 years of age employed between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make employment of minors more readily available and at the same time permit them to work in and about hotels.
