

STATE OF MAINE SENATE 108TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 336, L.D. 1121, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide that Regular Annual Reports of the Executive Branch be Made Through the Maine State Government Annual Report."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'<u>5 MRSA §45</u>, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 436, §4, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, every annual or biennial report required by statute to be made by any agency other than constitutional officers elected by the Legislature, the legislative and judicial branches of government, the University of Maine and the Maine Maritime Academy, to the Governor and the Legislature shall be made by inclusion of that report in the Maine State Government Annual Report. The Governor may authorize the publication of special expanded department reports in a limited quanity when justified.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes section 1 in the original bill and amends Title 5, section 45.
