HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 337, L.D. 1122, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Child Abuse and Neglect Laws.

Amend the Bill in section 9 in that part designated
"§3859." in subsection 1 by striking out all of the last
underlined sentence and inserting in its place the
following: 'Any person who permits or encourages the
unauthorized dissemination of their contents shall be
deemed guilty of a Class E crime, provided that notwithstand-
ing Title 17-A, section 4-A, subsection 4, no imprisonment
shall be imposed.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to bring the penalty
imposed under Title 22, section 3859 in line with other
provisions of the bill.
