SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 338, L.D. 1123, Bill,  
"AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Provide Services to Older  
Blind Persons to Assist them in Remaining in their Own Homes  
and in Caring for Themselves."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General  
Fund to the Department of Human Services, Division of Eye  
Care, for fiscal years 1977-78 and 1978-79  
the sum of \$80,000, which shall be used to contract for  
services for older blind persons in order to assist them in  
remaining in their own homes and in caring for themselves.  
The breakdown shall be as follows:
