IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Require Implementation of Standards of Treatment for Residential Drug Treatment Centers Related to Special Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 7115, sub-§ 1, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 566, § 1, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

The standards of treatment shall include a requirement that the residential drug treatment center provide special education services to patients residing therein pursuant to Title 20, chapter 404, which patients, between the ages of 5 and 20, shall be deemed exceptional children under Title 20, chapter 404.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require the Office of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Prevention to implement standards of treatment for residential drug treatment centers related to special education.
