**AN ACT to Prohibit Fish and Game Wardens from Trapping for Animals
unless a Local Trapper is Used for the Trapping.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 1907 is enacted to read:

§ 1907. Trapping by department personnel

No department personnel shall trap any animal pursuant to this Title, or any rules or regulations issued thereunder, unless the department shall employ a licensed trapper from the locality wherein the trapping is to be done, or as near thereto as practicable, to conduct the actual trapping.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that any trapping done by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall be conducted by a local trapper employed by the department.
