HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 952, L.D. 1146, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Limits for Elderly Householders' Tax and Rent Refunds."

Amend the amendment in section in that part designated "§6111." by striking out subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Disabled person. A person who has attained the age of 55 during the year for which relief is requested, and who, due to a disability, is receiving federal disability payments, such as supplemental security income.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include all disabled persons, age 55 or over, under the provisions of the bill. The fiscal note will remain unchanged at \$1,000,000.
