COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " H.P. 959, L.D. 1151, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide Limited Immunity to aid in Arson
Investigation."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of that part
designated "§2402." and inserting in its place the
following:

'§2402. Limited immunity

In the absence of fraud or malice, no insurance
company or person who furnished information on its behalf
to the Attorney General or his designee is liable for
damages in a civil action or subject to criminal prosecution
for any oral or written statement made pursuant to
investigations authorized pursuant to this chapter.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the
language of the bill.
