STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Imposition of Finance Charges on Purchases or Leases of Goods or Services Purchased During a Billing Period.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 9-A MRSA § 2-402, sub-§ 4 is enacted to read:
- 4. Except for cash advances, no finance charge shall be imposed on purchases or leases of goods or services purchased during the billing period, provided that they are paid for not later than 25 days from the creditor's billing date therefor.
