**AN ACT to Change the License Status of Maine Resident Military
Optometrists.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA § 2423, sub-§ 5 is enacted to read:

5. **Military service; license to practice optometry. A resident of the State who is serving in the military service of the United States and is engaged in the practice of optometry as defined in section 2411, shall be entitled to the issuance of an active license, upon payment of the required annual renewal fee.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to grant an active license to Maine residents in the military service engaged in the practice of optometry.
