SENATE AMENDMENT"A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 968, L.D. 1165, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Spending Ceiling for Education Purposes."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend the amendment in section 4 by striking out all of subsection 3 of that part designated "§3749." and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Additional local appropriations. Any additional appropriations approved by the legislative body of an administrative unit shall not be included in any future calculations of the administrative unit's elementary or secondary per pupil operating costs and shall not be included in any future calculations of the \$\footnote{8}\$tate's average or total operating costs.'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 by striking out all of subsection 5 of that part designated \$3749."

Further amend the amendment by renumbering sections to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate the need for a local administrative unit to come to the State Board of Education to justify funding under a hardship waiver. The amendment further specifies that additional local appropriations

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for education which exceed the "maintenance of effort" option will not be included in future education costs.
