**AN ACT Authorizing School Administrative Units to Charge a  
Driver Education Course Fee during the School Year.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 2454 is enacted to read:

§ 2454. School administrative unit fee during school year

A school administrative unit may charge a fee, based on the per pupil cost, for a driver education course at any time during the school year.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

The purpose of this bill is to allow a school district to offer driver education courses for a fee at any time during the school year, as most do in the summer, in order that the district may meet the full demand for the course without draining resources from other programs.
