STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys to the Maine State Housing Authority to Stimulate Housing Construction and Maintenance on Regional and Local Levels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State Housing Authority; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine State Housing Authority the sum of \$250,000 to be used to provide funds for regional and local organizations to stimulate housing construction and maintenance on regional and local levels. The breakdown shall be as follows:

MAINE STATE HOUSING AUTHORITY	1977-78
All Other	\$250,000

Any funds unexpended under this appropriation on June 30, 1978 shall not lapse but shall be carried forward to the next fiscal year to be expended for the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill appropriates \$250,000 to the Maine State Housing Authority to be used to stimulate construction and maintenance of housing on regional and local levels.
