STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Recognizing the Maine County Commissioners Organization as an Instrumentality of Maine's Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 30 MRSA § 7 is enacted to read:
- § 7. Maine County Commissioners Association

A county may raise or appropriate money to obtain the services of one or more nonprofit county advisory organizations. The Legislature recognizes the Maine County Commissioners Association as a nonprofit advisory organization and declares it to be an instrumentality of its member counties with its assets upon its dissolution to be delivered to the Secretary of State to be held in custody for the counties of the State. This county advisory organization may receive federal grants or contributions for its activities with respect to the solution of county problems.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit counties to raise or appropriate money to obtain the services of one or more nonprofit county advisory organizations. This bill also recognizes the Maine County Commissioners Association as a nonprofit county advisory organization.
