## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT to Repeal Certain Laws Relating to State Government Administrative Procedures and Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. 5 MRSA § 200 is repealed.
- Sec. 2. 5 MRSA § 204, as amended by PL 1973, c. 567, § 20, is repealed.
- Sec. 3. 5 MRSA c 15, as amended by PL 1975, c. 293, § 4, is repealed.
- Sec. 4. 5 MRSA § 1744 is repealed.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals certain unnecessary laws which provide for the Attorney General's attendance at law court, establish a preference for Maine granite and provide for the Board of Sanitation, licensing and inspection.
