RESOLVE, Authorizing the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands to Transfer Land to Mr. and Mrs. John Donnan.

Mr. and Mrs. John Donnan; land conveyed to. Resolved: That, pursuant to the Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 553, subsection 3, paragraph F, the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands is authorized, with the consent of the Commissioner of Conservation and upon payment of reasonable consideration determined by him, to execute a deed on behalf of the State conveying a portion of a public lot described in the report of commissioners dated September 13, 1910, recorded in Piscataquis County Registry of Deeds, volume 168, page 35, which portion contains approximately 1/10 of an acre and is bounded and described as follows:

Land bounded northerly by the shore of Onawa Lake, southerly by land of John H. Donnan et ux., easterly and westerly by northerly extensions of the easterly and westerly boundaries of said Donnan land.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to authorize the Director of Public Lands to transfer land to Mr. and Mrs. John Donnan.
