HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1009, L.D. 1212, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Allowing the Legislature to Impose a Different Rate of Taxation Upon Properties Outside of Incorporated Municipalities and Plantations.

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the first paragraph after the title and inserting in its place the following:

Amend the Resolution by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'RESOLUTION, proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Authorizing the Legislature to Levy a Separate Tax on Property in the Unorganized Territory to Provide Services only to the Unorganized Area.'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact and inserting in its place the following:

"Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by a resolution of the Legislature authorizing the Legislature to levy a separate tax on property in the unorganized territory to provide services only to the unorganized area?"
