AN ACT Concerning the Criminal Offense of Aggravated Assault.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

17-A MRSA § 208, sub-§ 1, as amended by PL 1975, c. 740, § 43, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

1. A person is guilty of aggravated assault if he intentionally, knowingly or recklessly causes bodily injury to another by means of a deadly weapon.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that aggravated assault results when a person intentionally, knowingly or recklessly causes bodily injury to another by means of a deadly weapon.
