AN ACT to Allow Sunday Hunting of Wild Birds by Residents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

¹² **MRSA § 2454**, 1st sentence, as last amended by PL 1969, c. 425, § 47, is further amended to read:

It shall be unlawful to hunt wild birds or wild animals on Sunday, **except that during any open season on wild birds any resident may hunt wild birds after 12 noon on Sunday.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would permit the hunting of wild birds by residents after 12 noon on Sundays during open season.
