STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Use of Commuter Passes on the Maine Turnpike.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P & SL 1941, c. 69, § 21 is enacted to read: Sec. 1.

Sec. 21. Commuter passes. The authority shall provide for the sale of commuter passes to users of the turnpike. A commuter pass shall entitle the purchaser to a toll discount for a number of toll payments, not to be less than 5.

Sec. 2. Allocation. There is allocated from the Highway Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1978 to the Maine Turnpike Authority, the sum of \$50,000. to provide passes for commuter use of the Maine Turnpike.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require the Maine Turnpike Authority to sell commuter passes to permit a toll discount to heavy users of the turnpike.
