SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 363,  
L.D. 1224, Bill, "AN ACT to Repeal Certain Laws Relating to  
Conservation."

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 21 the  
following:

'Sec. 22. 12 MRSA §2456-A is enacted to read:

§2456-A. Use of helicopter for transporting fishermen

No person shall use a helicopter for the purpose of trans-  
porting a sports fisherman or a sport fish to or from any pond  
under 10 acres in size or any beaver flowage.

Any person found guilty of violating any provisions of this  
section shall be punished in accordance with the provisions of  
section 2456.'

Further amend the amendment at the end before the statement of fact/the  
following: 'Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prohibit helicopters  
from flying into or out of small ponds and beaver flowages.
