HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 366, L.D. 1227, RESOLUTION,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Require the State
to Reimburse Municipalities for at least 50% of Property
Tax Exemption Losses.

Amend the Resolution in the Title by inserting before the
word "Losses" the words 'and Credit'

Further amend the Resolution by inserting at the end of the
first sentence of "Sec. 23." before the period and after the
word "exemptions" the following: 'or credits enacted after
April 1, 1978'

Further amend the Resolution by striking out all of the
question and inserting in its place the following:

"Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by a
resolution of the Legislature to require the State to reimburse
municipalities for at least 50% of property tax exemption and
credit losses?"

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the bill by:

1. Also requiring reimbursement for statutory property
tax credits; and
2. Limiting the reimbursement to exemptions and credits
enacted after April 1, 1978.
