STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Appropriating Funds for State Park Facilities at Swan Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Recreation, the sum of \$17,500, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1978 and the sum of \$6,952, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1979, to construct, operate and maintain state park facilities on Swan Lake. The breakdown shall be as follows:
