STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Concerning the Powers of the Eagle Lake Water and Sewer District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P & SL 1955, c. 162, § 13-A is enacted to read:

13-A. Powers. The district shall be deemed a municipality with a population of 1,000 or more for all purposes of the Revised Statutes, Title 30, chapters 235 and 237, shall conform, as nearly as practicable, to all the requirements of those chapters and shall have, as nearly as practicable, all the powers granted municipalities under those chapters.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill grants to the Eagle Lake Water and Sewer District all of the powers and duties, as nearly as practicable, granted municipalities under Title 30, chapter 235, "Revenue Producing Municipal Facilities Act," and chapter 237, "Sewers and Drains."
