SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1012, L.D. 1243, Bill,
"AN ACT Creating the Maine Development Foundation."

Amend the Bill in section 3 by striking out all of the first sentence and inserting in its place the following:

'There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$350,000 for the fiscal years 1977-78 and 1978-79 to assist the foundation in its efforts to foster, support and assist economic growth and and revitalization in the State.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the last line before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'All Other

\$100,000 \$150,000'

This amendment establishes funding for the bill at \$350,000.
