SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to  
H.P. 1004, L.D. 1244, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing the Maine  
Small Business Loan Authority."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after the 3rd paragraph  
the following:

'Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part  
designated "§8007." in subsection 1 by striking out all of  
the 2nd sentence and inserting in its place the following:

This fund shall initially be the sum of \$100,000.'

Further amend the Amendment in the 4th paragraph by  
striking out in the last line the underlined figure "\$5,000,000"  
and inserting in its place the underlined figure '\$2,500,000'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting at the end  
before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2  
and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the  
General Fund to the State Development Office the sum of \$100,000  
for fiscal year 1977-78 to establish the Maine Small Business  
Loan Insurance Fund. The breakdown shall be as follows:

1977-78

STATE DEVELOPMENT OFFICE

Maine Small Business Loan Insurance Fund      \$100,000

Any balance remaining in this account  
on June 30, 1978, shall not lapse, but  
shall remain in a continuous carrying

account to be carried forward from  
fiscal year to fiscal year to be  
expended for the purposes of this  
Act.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment reduces the appropriation to the Maine  
Small Business Loan Insurance Fund to \$100,000.
