COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 1028, L.D. 1246,
Bill, "AN ACT to Change the Deadline for Change in Party
Enrollment in Order to Qualify for Voting in a Primary
Election."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in the 9th and 10th
lines (8th line in L.D.) by striking out in 2 places
the underlined figure "14" and inserting in its place
the underlined figure '30'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in the 6th
line (5th line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined
figure "14" and inserting in its place the underlined
figure '30'

Further amend the Bill in section 3 in the 4th
line (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure
"14" and inserting in its place the underlined figure
'30'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change the
time requirement under the bill from 14 days to 30 days.
