STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to appropriate \$3,000, for the Kingman Fire Department in Kingman Plantation.

Kingman Plantation; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund to Kingman Plantation the sum of \$3,000, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1978, to be used for the completion of a fire house and the purchase of fire equipment.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Kingman Township is an unorganized township and fire protection is the responsibility of the Bureau of Forestry. At present the volunteer department has partially finished a fire house and passage of this resolve is necessary to complete it and to bring the equipment up to date for use in the summer of 1977.
