AN ACT Concerning Ice Fishing for Bass.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2651, last ¶ as enacted by PL 1971, c. 5, is repealed as follows:

~~Unless otherwise provided by rule and regulation, it shall be lawful to take black bass through the ice during the same period that it is lawful to take salmon and trout~~

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit ice fishing for bass at the same time as pickerel and perch.
