HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1160,  
L.D. 1252, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to School Funding and Inventory  
Tax Reimbursement."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 21 and  
inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 21. 36 MRSA §451-A is enacted to read:  
§451-A. Mill rate for fiscal year 1977-78

Notwithstanding the provisions of section 451, subsection 2,  
the uniform property tax rate shall be 11.5 mills for the period  
beginning July 1, 1977, and ending June 30, 1978.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of sections  
22, 23 and 24.

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the remaining  
sections to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

This amendment would retain the uniform property tax and  
would make an additional \$5.9 million in tax revenue available  
to the State.
