HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1160,  
L.D. 1252, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to School Funding and Inventory  
Tax Reimbursement."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the 2nd sentence  
of the 2nd paragraph of subsection 4 of section 12 and inserting  
in its place the following:

'The result shall be multiplied by 13 1/2% to determine the maximum  
allowable per pupil appropriation with state participation.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will set local leeway at \$125 in 1977-78.  
Because elementary and secondary education costs are reduced  
in the amendment from those provided in the bill, the percentage  
allowed for local leeway needs to be increased.
