

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 108TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1160, L.D. 1252, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to School Funding and Inventory Tax Reimbursement."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'<u>Sec. 4. Appropriation.</u> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services the sum of (\$3,086,860) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1977, and the sum of \$160,868,924 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1978, to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

All Other (\$3,086,860) \$160,863,924 Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of section 8 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 8. 36 MRSA \$451-A is enacted to read: \$451-A. Mill rate for fiscal year 1977-78

Notwithstanding the provisions of section 451, subsection 2, the uniform property tax rate shall be 11.5 mills for the period beginning July 1, 1977 and ending June 30, 1978.

## Statement of Fact

This bill establishes the total cost of education and the uniform property tax rate; increases the maximum leeway from \$00 to \$100 and appropriates

funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1078. The total cost of education established in this bill is \$200,603,234. Total state share is \$156,168,924. Total local share based on 11.5 mills is \$134,434,310. The appropriation is arrived at as follows:
