
SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1160,
L.D. 1252, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to School Funding and Inventory
Tax Reimbursement."

Amend the Amendment by inserting before the Emergency clause
the following:

'Sec. 10. Reimbursement funding. Any funds to be received
by the State of Maine under PL 94-369, Title II of the Public
Works Act of 1976 after April 1, 1977 shall be appropriated
to reimburse Maine cities and towns for 1973 inventory taxes
lost. Such additional moneys shall be apportioned based upon
the relative 1973 inventory taxes of each community to the total
1973 inventory tax collections of all communities.'

The purpose of this amendment is to generate additional
funds for reimbursement of inventories.
