COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1027, L.D. 1276, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Establishment of a Revolving Account for
Local Educational Assessment."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the Emergency
preamble.

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before
the Emergency clause the following:

' (2) Costs relating to the participation of any
administrative unit in the "Maine Assessment of
Educational Progress" shall not be considered in calculations
of the actual costs of education for purposes of reimburse-
ment under the provisions of chapter 512-A.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the
Emergency clause.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the emergency
preamble and emergency clause and to make clear that the costs
will not be included for purposes of reimbursement under the
School Finance Act.
