STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Concerning Motor Vehicles Located at Official Motor Vehicle Inspection Stations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 2122, 4th ¶, as amended by PL 1967, c. 443, § 1, is further amended to read:

Said inspection shall not apply to motor vehicles owned and registered in another state nor to new or used motor vehicles being driven by a dealer or holder of a transporter registration certificate or their authorized representatives from the point of distribution to his place of business, or to an official inspection station for the purpose of complying with this law, or a motor vehicle owned by a dealer or holder of a transporter registration that has a valid sticker until such time as the inspection sticker would have otherwise expired, at which time the motor vehicle must be reinspected.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill exempts from the motor vehicle inspection requirement vehicles which are being inspected at a motor vehicle inspection station.
