HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1057, L.D. 1287, Resolve,  
to Increase the Retirement Benefits of Helen B. Pearson.

Amend the resolve by striking out the period at the  
end and inserting in its place the following:

'; and be it further

Effective date. Resolved: That this resolve shall take  
effect 90 days after the adjournment of the Legislature,  
unless before that effective date Helen B. Pearson of Bremen  
is granted an occupational disability under the Maine State  
Retirement System which equals 2/3 of her average final  
compensation, in which case this resolve shall not take effect.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that if Helen B. Pearson is  
awarded  
successful in being/ an occupational disability allow-  
ance for which she has applied, she shall not be granted the  
additional retirement benefits under this resolve as there  
would be no need for them.
