STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Increase the Retirement Benefits of Helen B. Pearson.

Helen B. Pearson; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine State Retirement System the sum of \$20,000 for the fiscal year 1977-78 to be used to provide additional retirement benefits for Helen B. Pearson of Bremen.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill appropriates \$20,000 to the Maine State Retirement System to provide additional retirement benefits to Helen B. Pearson. In 1972, the Legislature appropriated \$20,000 to pay for medical and hospital expenses sustained by Helen B. Pearson while she was employed as a child welfare worker. Unfortunately, this appropriation lapsed without the \$20,000 being spent. This bill provides that the lapsed sum of money shall be paid into the Maine State Retirement System to provide her with additional retirement benefits.
