COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1056, L.D. 1288, Bill, "AN ACT to Repeal Certain Laws Relating to Transportation."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. 23 MRSA §§2401 - 2405 and §2407 are repealed.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 7.

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to remove a section of Title 23 concerning the care and equipment of ferries which was previously left in the statutes by the bill. In addition, the amendment also retains a provision repealed by the bill that permits individuals who are riding a horse to stop on coming traffic in the event that it is necessary to protect the animal.
