Amend the amendment by inserting at the end the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

Sec. 3. 7 MRSA §3604 is repealed'

Statement of Fact

This amendment repeals Title 7, section 3604 which permits a person to shoot a dog which assaults him. This law, adopted during the 19th century, allows a trespasser to shoot a watchdog which is protecting a person's property.
