STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend and Repeal Certain Laws Relating to Agriculture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 7 MRSA c. 103, sub-c. VI is repealed.

Sec. 2. 7 MRSA § 871 is repealed.

Sec. 3. 7 MRSA § 1085 is amended to read:

§ 1085. Common carriers

This subchapter shall not apply to railroad companies, ~~steamboat companies~~ express companies or other common carriers of property coming under the jurisdiction of the Interstate Commerce Commission or the Public Utilities Commission of this State, unless they knowingly violated such subchapter.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals a subchapter concerning flour, bread and rolls, repeals a section concerning marking of hay and deletes a reference to steamboat companies in a section exempting common carriers from a subchapter regulating vinegar.
