L.D. 1302, Bill, "AN ACT to Limit the Duration of Sentences

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last paragraph  
before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the  
following:

'6. The court may not sentence a person to imprisonment in a  
county jail for a period in excess of one year.'
