COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1078, L.D. 1302, Bill,
"AN ACT to Limit the Duration of Sentences to County Jails."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'17-A MRSA §1252, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

6. The court may not sentence a person to imprisonment in
a county jail for a period in excess of one year unless the
person requests or consents to such a sentence.'
