COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1091, L.D. 1315, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend and Repeal Certain Laws Relating to Public Utilities."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 10 and renumbering sections to read consecutively.

The intent of this amendment is to restore the provision concerning caboose cars to apply to the Waterville and Skowhegan line. While this line has not been operating, the line may be used extensively as the new Scott Plant in Hinckley develops.
