STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Exempt the Brick Store Museum at Kennebunk from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 1760, sub-§ 37 is enacted to read:

37-A. Services to the Brick Store Museum. Sales of goods and services to the Brick Store Museum.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill exempts from the sales tax, sales of goods and services to the Brick Store Museum, Kennebunk, Maine.
