IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Concerning the Renewal of Special License Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 192, 2nd ¶, first sentence, as amended by PL 1975, c. 589, § 5, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

The registration plates so provided shall be issued only upon application therefor, and upon payment of a one-time service fee of \$30. Thereafter, renewal of these registration plates shall be conducted under the same fees and procedures as section 191.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that application for special initial or initial and numeric registration plates shall be accompanied by a special fee of \$30 instead of the current \$10 special fee and deletes any special fee for renewal of these plates thereafter. This bill will therefor make renewal of these plates as easy as renewal of any other registration plates.
