HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1101, L.D. 1325, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow Limited Operation of an Unregistered Motor Vehicle."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Amendment in the first line after the title by striking out the word "Amend" and inserting in its place the words 'Further amend'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out in the 6th line the following: "may" and inserting in its place the following: 'shall'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §102, 2nd ¶, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 731, §24, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

However, any person who operates or permits to be operated any vehicle when the registration for the vehicle has expired within 30 days shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$100.' HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1101, L.D. 1325

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires the issuance of a permit instead of a summons. This amendment also imposes a fine in lieu of a criminal penalty for people who unknowingly operate a motor vehicle)without a valid certificate of registration in the first 30 days following expiration of the registration. Presently, people who operate a motor vehicle without a registration are guilty of a misdemeanor.
