HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 1209, L.D. 1329, Bill, "AN ACT
to Amend the Vocational Education Laws."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the amending clause
of section 8 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 8. 20 MRSA §2356-G, sub-§1, Region 10, as last repealed
and replaced by PL 1975, c. 573, §10, is amended to read:'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of that part
designated "Region 8." of section 8.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the island
communities of Monhegan and SAD No. 65--Matinicus; Isle au
Haut from the Bill as these communities are isolated and therefore
are unable to participate in the vocational program.
