Further amend the Amendment in Section 8 in the 2nd indented paragraph after the amending clause in the last line by striking out "S.A.D. No. 65--Matinicus"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the island communities of Monhegan and S.A.D. No. 65--Matinicus; Isle au Haut from the amendment as these communities are isolated and therefore are unable to participate in the vocational program.
