HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 386,
L.D. 1331, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Relief from Extremely
Burdensome Property Taxes."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 10th to
13th lines and inserting in their place the following:

'B. Is a person who has attained the age of 55 during
the year for which relief is requested, and who, due
to a disability, is receiving federal disability pay-
ments;'

Further amend the amendment in section 3, by inserting
in the first sentence, after the following word: "elderly"
the following: 'and disabled'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make the provisions of
the bill concerning entitlement apply to all disabled persons
over 55 who meet eligibility requirements.
