COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1114, L.D. 1332, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for Student and Faculty Members of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "Sec. 4" in subsection 3 by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

'No faculty member serving as a member of the board shall simultaneously be a member of or take any part in the activities of any collective bargaining unit pursuant to Title 26, chapter 12.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "Sec. 4" by striking out subsection 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Student member. One of the members shall be a full-time student at any campus of the University of Maine at the time of his appointment and who shall maintain permanent residency in the State of Maine. The student member shall be a full voting member of the board of trustees, and shall serve for a term of 2 years and until his successor is qualified. The student member shall be eligible for reappointment if at the time of his reappointment he continues to meet all requirements for appointment as a student member of the board. The student member shall be appointed by the Governor within 30 days after a list of 3 eligible students has been submitted to him by the University of Maine Organization of Student Governments.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is to provide that no faculty member serving as a member of the board shall simultaneously be a member of or take any part in the activities of any collective bargaining and also adds a student member to the board.
